Four of us attended the Emery Garden event. We had a question and answer session and walked through the tree area, which was quite a temptation during a 30% off everything and 40% off trees sale.

I definitely learned what I wanted to about moving large plants and trees. Specifically to do some **ROOT PRUNING** this fall in preparation to move plants when dormant in early spring. Contact the **BIG TREES** people to move larger items or fragile valuables like an 8 foot tall red lace-leaf maple tree that could easily be broken if one person tried to do it. Dividing of yucca's can be done any time not blooming, and they are actually hard to kill, and grow from just a string of root, so I am no longer afraid to divide them, except I need to armor up from the sharp leaves.
